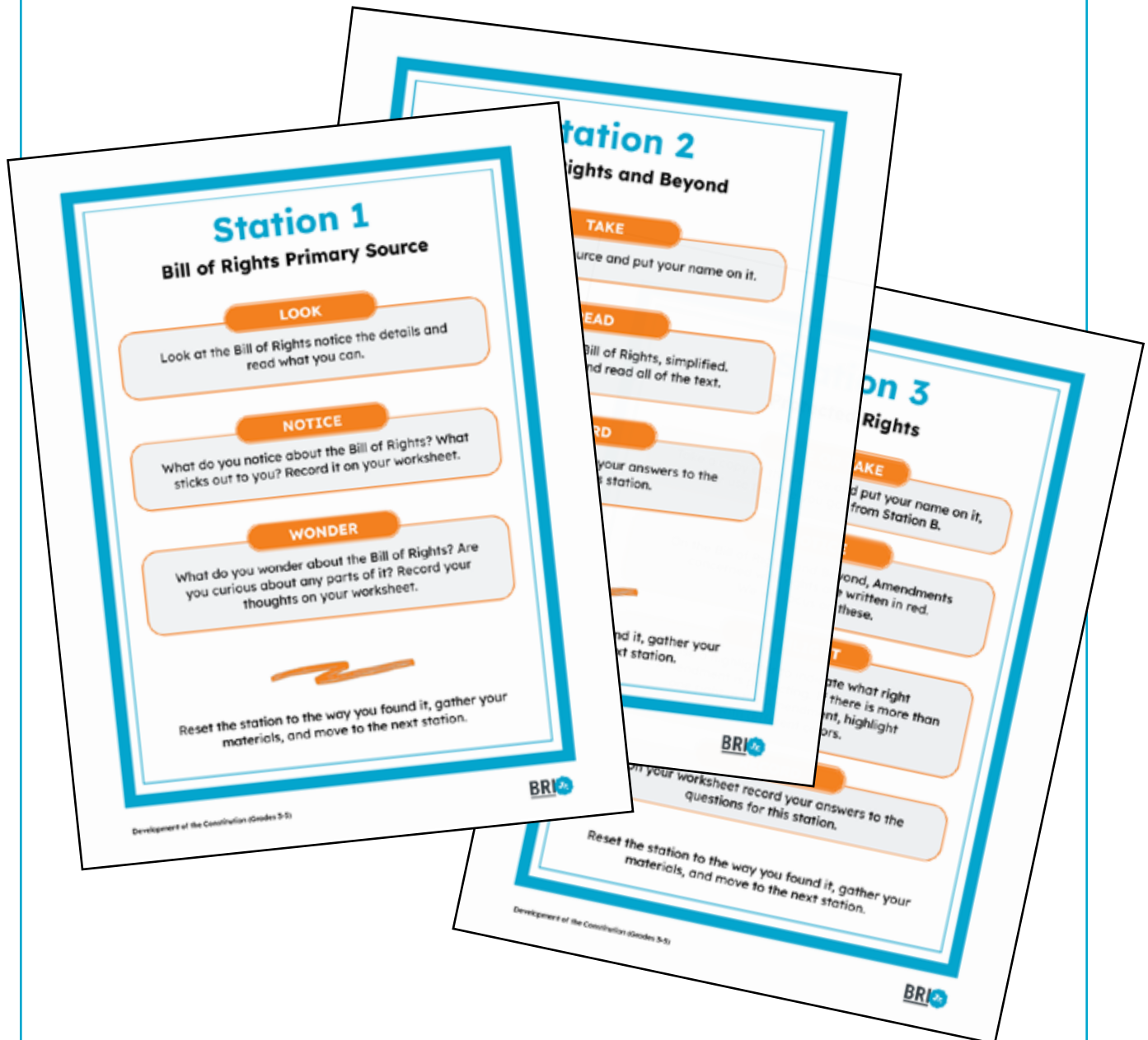


Explore #2 Stations

Station Instructions

Use these slides to create posters for your stations activity.



Station 1

Bill of Rights Primary Source

LOOK

Look at the Bill of Rights notice the details and read what you can.

NOTICE

What do you notice about the Bill of Rights? What sticks out to you? Record it on your worksheet.

WONDER

What do you wonder about the Bill of Rights? Are you curious about any parts of it? Record your thoughts on your worksheet.

Station 2

Bill of Rights and Beyond

TAKE

Take a copy of the source and put your name on it.

READ

This document is the Bill of Rights, simplified.
Notice all of the art and read all of the text.

RECORD

On your worksheet record your answers to the
questions for this station.

Station 3

Protected Rights

USE OR TAKE

Take a copy of the source and put your name on it, or use the one you got from Station B.

NOTICE

On the Bill of Rights and Beyond, Amendments concerned with rights are written in red.
We will focus on these.

HIGHLIGHT

Use a highlighter to indicate what right the Amendment is protecting. If there is more than one right in the Amendment, highlight with different colors.

RECORD

On your worksheet record your answers to the questions for this station.
