

# Lesson 6 Glossary

Glossary terms are listed in the order in which they appear.

<b>Moderation</b>	The avoidance of excess or extremes.
<b>Prudence</b>	Practical wisdom that applies reason and other virtues to discern right courses of action in specific situations.
<b>Popular Sovereignty</b>	A political doctrine according to which the people of federal territories decide for themselves whether their territories would enter the Union as free or slave states.
<b>Immunity</b>	Legal protection from prosecution or punishment.
<b>Enumerated</b>	Powers or rights that are specifically listed.
