Handout C: TikTok's Conduct Isn't Free Speech	<i>The article supports the bill because he believes it addresses a legitimate security concern and doesn't violate freedom of speech.</i>	<i>Students should note the author's basic arguments about national security, and the difference between conduct of speech and content of speech.</i>
